Each of these adventures derails in severe, alarming ways, only to resurface and collide two decades later in an unforgettable finale that explores the power—and limits—of the narratives that come to define us. Deftly written and peopled with precisely drawn, indelible characters pushed to great

extremes, *Who You Might Be* considers the ramifications of life's most trying encounters and the resilience it takes to determine for ourselves who we might be.
